## Introduction

The course structure for JACE Foundation Learning is both flexible and personal. If you have less than 5 GCSE's at Grade C (or higher) now is your chance to "have another go" and improve your chances for the future.

JACE Foundation Learning is a collection of full or part qualifications chosen by yourself at entry or level 1. It is one of the 4 qualification suites for 14-19 year olds (foundation learning, GCSE's, diplomas and apprenticeships).

Foundation Learning Programmes offer you a mix of vocational learning, functional skills and personal & social development. Where possible we also try to offer a creative or physical option if timetabling allows.

The opportunity of vocational choice offers you a pathway towards level 2 of the same vocation as an apprenticeship or other routes.

You with your key worker will plan an individual learning programme which states your starting point and intended destination. This programme can be adjusted during your time with JACE.

You will receive help and support, information and guidance, initial assessment and regular review.
