## YOUTHWORK TRAINING WITH JACE

Youth Work is about working with young people to help them develop their life skills in an informal atmosphere. Youth Work can happen in many different places, from youth centres and schools to on the street via a detached youth project. Youth Work involves supporting and working alongside young people and could be one to one, in small groups or in a larger centre. You will learn skills and techniques to deal with situations and to promote young people's learning. You will also get to put these into practice and develop positive working relationships with young people and see the outcomes first hand.



## WHILST PREPARING FOR YOUR PLACEMENT

Whilst waiting to start your work placement there is plenty to cover. You can begin learning about functional skills, your employment rights and responsibilities and our induction training which will cover basic health and safety, safeguarding, equal opportunities and the principles you will be working towards. This can be one to one, online or in small groups. You will also be assigned an assessor who will keep in contact with you and help you prepare for when your placement starts. Your assessor will then stay with you throughout your course and help you to progress during your learning journey.



## The Apprenticeship

### What is in the Apprenticeship

The Apprenticeship is made up of a number of sections:

- \* A Certificate or Diploma in Youth Work
- \* Functional Mathematics
- \* Functional ICT
- \* Functional English
- \* Employment Rights and Responsibilities

### Youth Work

The Youth Work Certificate or Diploma is the main part of your work. To complete this you will need to study both underpinning knowledge and demonstrate competence through practice in a Youth Work environment. By being in a real workplace you gain invaluable skills in the practical side from your mentor and team from their experiences.

### Functional Skills

Mathematics, ICT and English are all needed to help you progress. We offer a blend of one to one, group and online learning solutions to help you develop these skills to get ahead at work.

### Employment Rights & Responsibilities

Knowing your rights and responsibilities as an employee is very important to make sure you are protected at work and that you know how to protect yourself and employer. A good understanding of these will ensure you are able to progress in your workplace.

## Other Apprenticeships on offer

### Childcare

This qualification will help you to learn and develop skills in looking after children primarily those in the 0-8 age range and in a variety of different settings such as day nurseries, pre schools and reception classes.

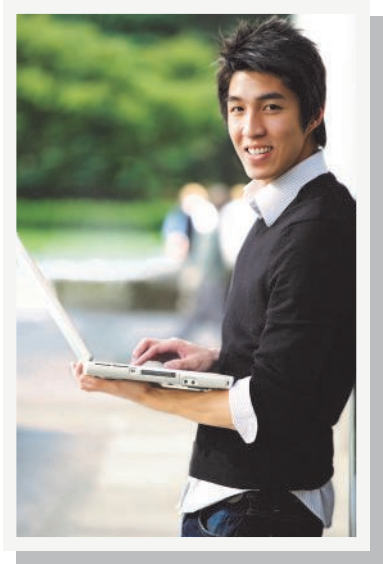
